

Amendment to the Hicksville Baseball by-laws, October, 2005.

ALL STARS

1. Only the managers of the in-house teams, along with the director of the division, the president of the division, and at least one trustee, are present at “all star” drafts. (The Commissioner is always welcome.)
2. Managers and coaches of the “all star” team must have been a manager or coach on the “in-house” teams for the current year.
3. The managers and coaches of the “all star” team will be picked by the director of the division, the president of the division, and the commissioner.
4. The names of the managers and coaches will not be revealed to anyone, including the manager and coaches, until after the “all star” draft is concluded.
5. “All Stars” are selected based on their present performance in the “in-house” program, NOT any previous year, or past performance as an “all star”.
6. There will be NO discussion on potential “all star” candidates among managers and/or coaches before the draft.
7. There are no alternates.
8. The final decision, on ANY problem that may arise, will be made by the division director and the president of the division.
9. Whatever is discussed at the draft WILL NOT be discussed with anyone outside after the conclusion of the draft to protect the children’s feelings.
10. Uniforms will be purchased by the players at a designated store. The uniform will be selected by the Board of Directors. Hats will be supplied by HBA. Any deviation from the selected uniform or hat will result in the immediate suspension of the manager and/or coaches for the entire season, with the possibility of the entire season being canceled. (It is the Board’s intention to use the same style uniform as an age group progresses to minimize the expense to the parents.)

11. Tournaments will be limited. Tournaments will be approved by the Director, President, and the Commissioner, NOT the manager and coaches.
12. The first meeting with the all star team and their parents will be attended by the Director and the President of the respective division.
13. All star managers MUST be accessible by phone, cell phone, and e-mail. They MUST stay in contact with players, parents, and the HBA Board of Directors at all times.
14. A player may NOT participate in any other baseball or softball organization during the Williamsport Tournament. Any person who manages or coaches in CYO, PAL, FABL, or any other baseball or softball organization, is prohibited from coaching or managing in the Williamsport Tournament.
15. There will be NO 'all star' draft until all evaluations are completed and returned to the Director of the Division.
